


OVERVIEW

ABOUT THE TOUR:

- Participants should carefully read all the terms and conditions of this tour to fully understand and agree to everything before joining. This is a hiking tour, and therefore, self-independence is crucial. It is advised that this tour is open only to individuals with experience in multi-day hiking, such as those who have conquered EBC, Mount Kilimanjaro, or other extreme hikes. It is not suitable for those with zero hiking experience.
- Hiking is inherently a risky activity, and it is important for participants to acknowledge and understand the associated risks when signing up for the tour. RC Wanderlust will not be held responsible for any incidents or accidents that may occur during the trip. Participants are expected to exercise caution, follow safety guidelines, and make informed decisions throughout the tour. It is highly recommended that participants obtain appropriate travel insurance to cover any unforeseen circumstances or emergencies. By joining the tour, participants accept full responsibility for their own safety and well-being.
- To sign up for the tour, a first deposit of RM 500 will be collected to reserve your spot, followed by an additional RM 1500 once the tour has a sufficient number of participants and is confirmed. The remaining tour fee can be settled through monthly installments. The final balance payment is due 30 days before the departure date. Failure to comply will result in the cancellation of the booking.
- It is mandatory that the full payment of the tour fee be settled at least 30 days before the departure date. If you are unable to join due to personal reasons, you will need to find a replacement in order to receive a full refund. A full refund will only be available if I am unable to gather enough participants to run the tour. Strictly no refunds will be issued if you decide not to participate at the last minute.

- Please note that the paid deposit and tour fees are strictly non-refundable, except in the event of tour cancellation by RC Wanderlust. In the case of unforeseen calamities such as a pandemic outbreak, adverse weather conditions, political reasons, riots, war, terrorist attacks, etc., RC Wanderlust will not be held responsible for any losses incurred, including local tour and accommodation cancellation charges, air ticket cancellation, delay or reschedule losses, currency exchange rate differences for money transfers, refunds, or any other transactions, and non-refundable documentations such as visa fees and LOI (Letter of Invitation).
- Please note that Ryan Chu (RC) or any tour leader from Malaysia will not be accompanying this tour. Instead, the tour is a collaboration with a trusted local community and experienced mountain hikers from the Gilgit-Baltistan region, with over 20 years of experience.
- Regarding communication, it is advisable to purchase a pocket Wi-Fi or e-SIM card from your home country. Network coverage in the mountain regions is limited, and it is unlikely that you will have network signal except in Skardu and Islamabad.
- Participants should understand that certain parts of the itinerary require a certain level of physical fitness, especially when hiking in high altitude regions. Therefore, this tour is suitable only for individuals with good fitness levels and is not recommended for those with limited physical capabilities. Please be aware that this tour is categorized as "EXTREME DIFFICULTY" and is exclusively open to experienced hikers who are eager to conquer K2 Basecamp. Participants with no hiking experience are not allowed to join due to the level of difficulty involved.
- It is important to note that helicopter rescue services are not available in Pakistan. In the event of altitude sickness, the only option would be for porters to carry you to a lower altitude. Therefore, if you are susceptible to altitude-related issues, please come prepared accordingly. It is crucial to monitor your breathing and stay hydrated throughout the trip. If necessary, please consult your doctor and bring any required medications.

T&C (3/5)

- Pakistan is a predominantly Muslim country, and it is essential to respect local cultures and dress modestly. Avoid exposing too much skin to avoid drawing unnecessary attention from the locals. For females, wearing a headscarf is recommended, and when visiting mosques, it is mandatory to cover your knees and wear a headscarf. Please be sure to adhere to these guidelines to ensure a respectful and enjoyable experience for both participants and the local community.
- Regarding hotel accommodation, please be informed that rooms are arranged on a double occupancy basis, with two persons sharing a room. Couples will be provided with a double bed, while non-couples will have two single beds per room. However, in some cases where beds are limited, non-couples may be allocated rooms with a queen-size bed. It's important to note that amenities such as a kettle, hairdryer, and toiletries are generally not provided in the rooms.
- Please be aware that, apart from Islamabad and Skardu, there will be no electricity in other regions as they are rural areas with no permanent residents. It is crucial to come prepared with any necessary items, such as portable power sources or batteries, to meet your personal needs. Power generators are available for rent at an approximate cost of 500-600 USD per rental, excluding porter services. Personal porters can be hired at a cost of 200 USD per porter, who will assist in carrying your belongings during the hiking days.
- Please remember that this tour is exclusively open to experienced hikers. Only individuals with prior hiking experience are eligible to join due to the challenging nature of the journey.

T&C (4/5)

- It is important to note that taking photos of the locals without their permission is considered rude and disrespectful, especially for local females who are often shy and prefer to cover their faces when a camera is present. Participants must understand that in Pakistan, sharing someone's photo online without permission can have negative consequences, especially for local females. Therefore, it is crucial to always ask for permission politely before taking someone's photo.
- Regarding local currency, Pakistani rupees, we will exchange it for USD upon arrival in Lahore, Pakistan. It is advised to exchange with new and crisp \$100 notes, as smaller banknotes may receive lower exchange rates. Please be aware that credit cards are only accepted in certain parts of Lahore and Islamabad.
- When it comes to medicine, the requirements may vary for each individual. It is recommended that participants bring their own necessary medications. Common medicines for flu, fever, diarrhea, motion sickness, and other common ailments are advisable to have on hand.
- Last reminder, this tour is exclusively open to experienced hikers only.

OTHERS:

- RC Wanderlust will not be responsible if participants unable to board the plane or enter the country with anything that due to lack of or false travel documents.
- RC Wanderlust will not be responsible if participant is found or caught by local authorities for conducting anything illegal.
- Participants should understand that the itinerary or program will subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances for instance war issue, riots, any form of pandemic outbreak, weather etc.

ABOUT COVID-19:

- After since the hit of covid 19, travel with vaccination document is a must. Please do refer to local covid-19 policy for more details.
- Travel during the epidemic can be different than what it used to before, it is important to understand and agreed with all the up to date latest regulations set by the government for all the countries involved in this tour (including the transit destinations). It is advised to get yourself a travel insurance with covid-19 coverage.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

- Tour is most likely cancelled if we are unable to get sufficient number of participants 30 days before the departure date. All the paid deposits and fees can be refunded or can be kept as credits for any other tours by RC.
- Refund of tour fee and deposit due to change of mind or any other personal problems by customers will not be entertained, however customer can find replacement.
- As for cancellation due to outbreak pandemic eg: Covid-19 or other similar form of outbreak, war and unforeseen calamity, refund minus any cost incurred will be made once official travel restriction is issued. Cost incurred includes cancellation charges and non-refundable refunds by local third party drivers or tour operators, currency exchange rates difference and other losses incurred.



关于团:

- ·团友必须在报名前仔细阅读了解和同意所有内容和条款才报名。这是爬山团,所以独立心非常的重要。 RC是不会对团友提供任何保姆式服务。建议只对徒步或爬山有经验的人参加,例如那些曾征服过EBC、Kilimanjaro或挑战过其他高难度山路的团友参加。这团并不适合零徒步经验者参加。爬山或徒步活动本身具有风险,参与者在报名参加时应了解和知道相关风险的存在。RC Wanderlust对这爬山团期间可能发生的任何事故或意外不承担责任。团友应谨慎行事,遵守安全指南,并在整个团的过程中做出明智的决策。强烈建议团友购买适当的旅游保险,以应对任何意外情况或紧急情况。团友必须承担对自己的安全和福祉负全部责任。·
- 有兴趣想报名参加的朋友,RC将会收取 RM 500 的订金以报名标准,一旦人数足够后,将会再收取第二笔 RMI500 订金。其余团费可以每个月分期付款方式来付。最终余额必须在出发日期前 30 天前付清。

条规

- 至于simcard 方面,建议自己带pocket WiFi 来。也必须知道山区部分网络非常有限。山区的网络覆盖范围有限,除了斯卡杜和伊斯兰堡外,您可能无法获得网络信号。
- 参与者应了解到,爬山团是需要一定的体力来完成,特别是在高海拔地区徒步时更为重要。请注意,此团难度是被归类为"极高-难度",此团只开放给体力好的团友参与,不建议身体能力有限的人参加。由于其难度级别,再次强调不允许没有徒步经验的参与者参加。
- 需要注意的是,在巴基斯坦没有直升机救援服务。如果有严重高原反应,唯一的选择是由当地人一起将您抬到较低的海拔。因此,如果您容易受到与高海拔相关的问题,请做好相应的准备。在整个旅程中,多注意自己的呼吸并保持身体的水分供应是至关重要的。如有需要,请咨询您的医生并携带所需的药物。
- 巴基斯坦是穆斯林占多数的国家,尊重当地文化和宗教是一定要的。穿着方面也必须要注意,以免引起不必要的注意和麻烦。女团友可以选择戴上头巾。
- 关于酒店住宿,请注意我们都会安排两人一房式。夫妻将提供双人床,而非夫妻的参与者将每间房提供两张单人床。然而,在一些床位有限的情况下, 非夫妻可能会被安排到带有大号双人床的房间。需要注意的是,房间通常不提供烧水壶、吹风机和洗浴用品等设施。
- 请注意,除了伊斯兰堡和斯卡杜,其他地区都没有电力供应,因为是没有人居民的郊外地区。所以团友必须提前准备必要的物品,如便携式电源或电池等。发电机可供租赁,每次租赁费用大约为500-600美元,不包括搬运工服务。您可以雇佣个人背夫,每位背夫搬运工费用为200美元,他们将在徒步日子里帮助您搬运。

拍照前必须先得到当地人的允许,没先得到当地人的允许就拍照是很没礼貌的行为。尤其是当地女生,大多数都非常害羞和不喜欢被拍。团友必须明白在巴基斯坦,如果照片被发现在网上分享尤其是女性,可能会对照片里的人造成不良后果。

对于当地货币巴基斯坦卢比,我们将在抵达巴基斯坦拉合尔时使用美元或人民币进行兑换。建议更换 100 美元的大钞票,因为根据我的经验,较小100以下的钞票会受到低很多的汇率。信用卡只在伊斯兰堡的部分地区用得到,山区是肯定不收信用卡。

- 对于药物,这取决于个人。如果您认为有必要,请自备药物。您可以携带一些感冒、发烧、腹泻、晕车等常用药物。
- 由于其难度级别,再次强调不允许没有徒步经验的参与者参加。

关于疫情:

·自从新冠病毒爆发以来,团友必须携带疫苗接种证书旅行。请参阅当地的巴基斯坦疫苗政策了解更多详情。建议团友购买一份涵盖 covid-19 的旅行保险。

其他:

- 如果团友有因为缺少或伪造旅游证件而导致无法登机, RC Wanderlust 绝对不负责。
- RC Wanderlust 将不负责如果团友被地方当局发现或被捕扣留因为进行任何非法活动。
- ·团友应了解行程或计划可能会因不可预见的情况而改变,例如战争问题、骚乱、任何形式的流行病爆发、天气变化等。

取消政策:

- 如果在出发日期前的30天无法凑足够人数,那么这团可能会取消。所有已支付的团费可以用在其他团或其他团日或者也可以选择退还,团费也可以作为Credit保留给未来用。
- 如果客户因为个人原因改变主意或因为任何其他个人问题而不参与,所还过的团费和押金都无法退还,但可以找人替代。
